Digital Literacy in Admapur

Digital literacy is critical in the 21st century. Familiarity with the internet and smart devices, had been identified as one of the key skills required for the future because it played a great role in terms of improved incomes, knowledge, access to opportunities and access to government schemes.

In 2015, only 1 out of every 10 internet user in rural India was a woman. Tata Trusts and Google came together to address this huge gender gap and introduced a digital literacy program, based on 'train the trainer' model (http://internetsaathiindia.org/). Women from villages are trained on using the Internet and are made equipped with data-enabled devices. These women are known as Internet Saathis and work as trainers, to help other women in their village to get started on their Internet journey and benefit from it.

In the backdrop of this, the Department of Computer Studies, CSIBER has taken an initiative of creating digital literacy in Admapur village. One week training programme is arranged in association with D.K. Shinde School of Social Work for members of Self-help group from 12/02/2019 to 16/02/2019. Twenty ladies of Admapur Self-help group were participated in this training programme and benefitted. The detail of the training programme is given here in this report.

"If The Village Perish, India Will Perish Too"- Mahatma Gandhi

A Digital Village is a space where a community expresses their identity though ICT and Digital Media. This can be done through poetry, digital stories, community newspapers online, image collections (old and new), audio (Internet radio, oral history), animations, video, and text.

Simplest a Digital Village is a community website. A Digital Village becomes a vehicle for participant led learning where the interests of the learning community set the agenda for what they learn. This is done using Community Media and innovative use of ICT, particularly open source software and web applications. Literacy rate in rural areas was pegged at 71 per cent last year, compared to 86 per cent in urban areas; (NSSO survey IRJCS ISS 12 VOL3 Dec-16) Adult literacy rate was 64% in rural as compared to 84 % in urban areas. (Age 15 years above).

Smart Village = Ideal Village + Digital Village

To use the E-Technologies of E-Governance, Digital Literacy is imminent. Digital Literacy plays a vital role in the mediation or bridging of common people and E-Government together, ICT is a tool to achieve this.

- All the citizens of the village should be made aware of why Digital Literacy is required and its benefits.
- All should know how they are benefited with Digital Literacy.
- How Digital Literacy is going to help in E-Governance.
- How villagers can contact and understand the working of Government without depending on this middlemen or agencies.
- All should be aware of the advantage of real time, online facilities.

Main objective of our study is to give basic computer training to villagers & equip them to conduct digital transactions & make them financially literate. After the training the villagers should write emails, make bank transaction & browse the web. If possible they will be trained

to learn new methods of farming and understand the market to sell their products at adapt APT prices (E-Sage)

(Computers, WI-FI hotspot, LED Screen)

Methodology:

Around 300 villagers (respondents) will be selected by convenient method of sampling from the village. The main respondents include eligible children, Youth, Businessman and Farmers.

After collecting the data (By Interview Schedule) from each villager (respondent) in respect of their status, age, livelihood etc. These selected respondents will be trained by making use of ICT. All the villagers will be trained to perform digital transactions through their mobile.

School Kit Distribution Activity

Concept:- Flood 2019 affected almost one lakh students in the Kolhapur and Sangli Districts. Under CSIBER cares initiatives, we tried to reach around 1500 students in the affected area. The faculty and students identified the affected students in the area. After confirmation the team distributed school kits in the identified Schools / Area.

1) Concept: - In order to help the flood affected students it was decided to provide School kits to the primary as well as secondary School Students. Based on that the school kits were prepared. It was decided to prepare 750 kits for each group.

Primary School Kit: - It contains one school bag, 6- 74 pages notebooks, one pen, and stationary pouch having pencil, Eraser, Sharpener and one Crayon set.

Secondary School Kit: - It contains One Scholl bag, 6 184 pages notebooks, one pen and one compass box.







DETAILS

School Kit Distribution Activity

Concept:- Flood 2019 affected almost one lakh students in the Kolhapur and Sangli Districts. Under CSIBER cares initiatives, we tried to reach around 1500 students in the affected area. The faculty and students identified the affected students in the area. After confirmation the team distributed school kits in the identified Schools / Area.

A) School Kit Initiatives by CSIBER cares Team

1) Concept: - In order to help the flood affected students it was decided to provide School kits to the primary as well as secondary School Students. Based on that the school kits were prepared. It was decided to prepare 750 kits for each group.

Primary School Kit: - It contains one school bag, 6- 74 pages notebooks, one pen, and stationary pouch having pencil, Eraser, Sharpener and one Crayon set.

Secondary School Kit: - It contains One Scholl bag, 6 184 pages notebooks, one pen and one compass box.




