2. The research paper should not be more than 7000 words (excluding tables, figures and references)
3. The research paper should cover the following aspects:
 - a. The study hypothesis (if applicable)
 - b. Brief literature review
 - c. Methodology adopted/Experimental Setup
 - d. Empirical or theoretical results
 - e. Inductive research if applicable
 - f. Implications for theory and practice
 - g. Keywords
 - h. Research papers of conceptual research or inductive research are accepted for the conference
 - i. Case studies relevant to the International Conference theme are also acceptedPlease note that incomplete submission will not be sent out for the review process

Formatting of paper/extended abstract

1. One document of Word file and one document of PDF file required.
2. Figures, graphs, tables, references, and appendices should follow APA/Harvard style.
3. Font: Times New Roman 12, 1.5 line spacing, 1 - inch (2.5 cm) margin all around.
4. To facilitate the review process, please provide all author identity including acknowledgements. We treat it with confidence.

Today, Kolhapur is a modern and industrialized city.

Situated at an altitude of 1900 feet above the sea level, Kolhapur enjoys a pleasant climate for the major part of the year. The best time to visit Kolhapur is from October to March.
