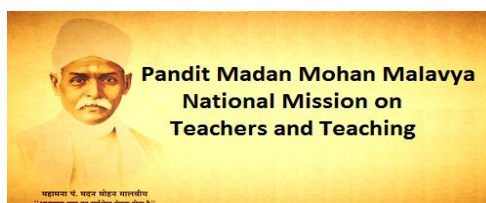

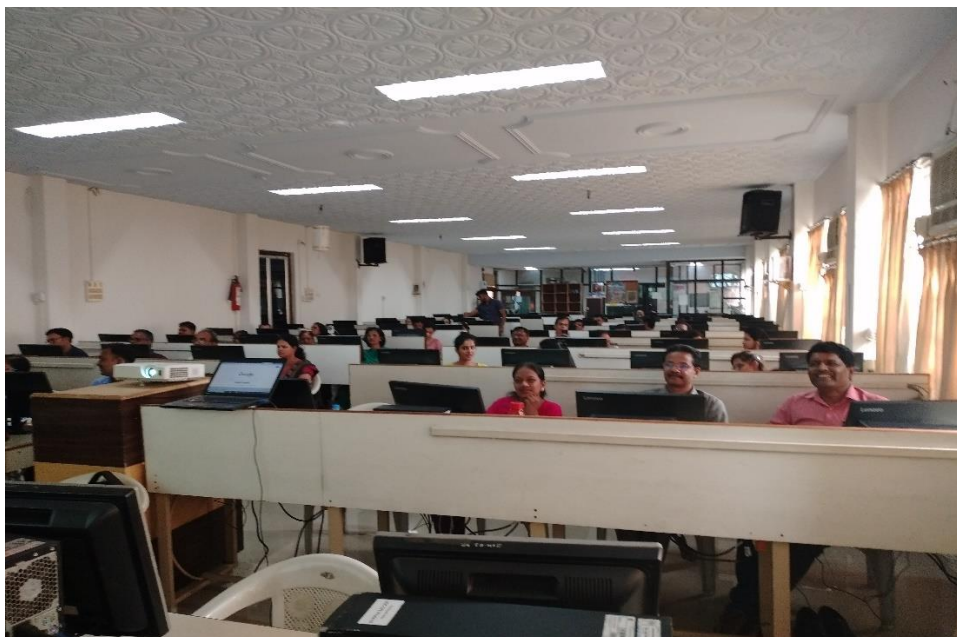
FDP Session

All the said topics discussed with hands-on and participants' queries were cleared. The first day concluded with the review of whatever deliberated during sessions.

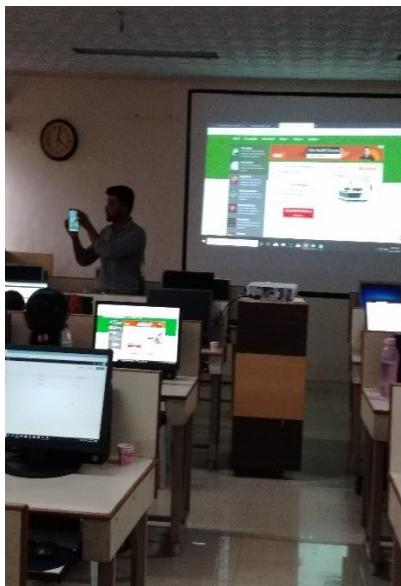


Day 2: 3rd December, 2019
