Research Policy

CSIBER, Kolhapur is committed for quality research and also to their vision statement that is "To be an Institute of First choice of Students" by framing tailor-made research policy suitable for the local conditions which is essential for prioritizing, executing and monitoring the research conducted at CSIBER. This policy should help in achieving the ultimate aim of "Quality Research" in a systematic manner with optimized and focused efforts. The purpose of this document is to present a research policy frame work for the design, management, optimizing infrastructure and development at CSIBER. Faculty are required to participate in research, publish their work and participate in national and international conferences to present the research data and generate new concepts in the emerging areas, if required by collaborating with other national and foreign universities. The Research policy should ensure adherence to the principles of professionalism, transparency, accountability and auditability in research at CSIBER.

Gudelines:

- 1) The research conducted at the CSIBER, Kolhapurt should be conducted as per the guidelines by UGC / AICTE/Shivaji University, Kolhapur fulfilling other ethical/legal requirements.
- 2) The Research publications from the Institute faculty should follow UGC CARE guidelines for reporting their research work.
- 3) If required, there should be an ethical committee constituted and functioning as per the guidelines of Government of India.
- 4) The Research related committees like a) DRC b) RAC c) RRC to be constituted and function as per UGC,AICTE,and Shivaji University guidelines.
- 5) The researchers and faculty of National and International eminence should be invited to visit campus and interact with the faculty members and research students.
- 6) The faculty members and research scholars/students should be encouraged for research publications/presentations by providing annual research awards.
- 7) The faculty members should be encouraged to undertake major and minor Research Projects by providing
 - a) Seed capital not exceeding 30% of the proposal estimate.
 - b) Research facilities like computer and other related facilities
- 8) Budgetary allocation for organizing research related Workshops, Conferences. Seminars, Faculty Development Programmes.
- 9) The research scholars/students should be encouraged to undertake research projects by providing research facilities such as research laboratory with internet connectivity, open access to research laboratory with various statistics packages to conduct qualitative and exploratory research, and well equipped library with online resources.
